Provides:

One night of shelter including meal, clothing & counseling for a survivor of domestic violence

A new suitcase for an abused or neglected child entering foster care

Ten nutritious lunches for senior citizens

Two weeks of counseling for a homeless child

Houses & feeds three people for one night in PADS



\$3 a week ... (movie rental or magazine)

Provides:

Play therapy assessment for five children

One month of music therapy for older adults with dementia

Work clothes & boots needed for construction jobs for two adults

Two children with a year's worth of school supplies

Ten hours of counseling for homeless children

The cost of prescription drugs for an individual for an average week



\$5 a week ... (foot-long sub sandwich or coffee drink)

Provides:

Foreclosure prevention counseling to help a family keep their home

Ten trained CASA volunteers with gas cards to help ensure an abused or neglected child remains in a safe environment

Ten sessions of individual counseling with a Senior Caregiver Specialist

One person with 3 months of case mgt. & resources to live independently

Household essentials for one family moving into a new home



\$10 / \$15 a week ... (one large pizza or a movie and popcorn)

Provides:

Five nights of safe, secure shelter for a battered woman and her child

Three months of violence reduction counseling for (12) twelve men

Six weeks of adult day care for one older adult with dementia

4-week job training & coaching to secure employment for an adult

Six-months therapy for a homeless child

The food pantry with the ability to purchase \$3,120 worth of food from the Northern Illinois Food Bank / \$1=\$6



\$20 - \$25 a week ... (1/2 tank of gas or dinner at a restaurant)

Provides:

Full year of one-to-one youth mentoring services

Three months of adult day care for one older adult

Parenting classes for (12) twelve homeless adults

Monitoring & follow-up assistance for two families moving out of Hesed's Transitional Living Community
